Rapport du Vice-Président Exécutif **Executive Vice-President's Report**

En temps que Vice-président exécutif, j'ai eu l'honneur et le privilège d'aider l'association au cours de cette année difficile. Tous ceux qui se sont impliqués de près ou de loin dans l'Association de soccer de NDG ont travaillé très fort en 2009 pour perpétuer la vision que nous partageons avec notre défunt Président, Jean Daniel Eigenmann.

J'ai continué à aider l'association à titre de Trésorier puisque ce poste était resté vacant. As a team, Eric Bonfanti and I have continued to try and expand the services offered to the players and coaches of NDG Soccer and ensure that all coaches receive the technical support and training that they require and deserve. I have continued to work very closely with our Technical Director to constantly improve our player selection process and player development strategies. I was very proud when these initiatives produced the very happy results of two more NDGSA competitive teams attaining AAA status in 2009. We now have 4 AAA teams representing the NDG Soccer Association and the borough of CDN/NDG provincially. We also saw an increase in the number of recreational teams moving up to create competitive teams – this represents wonderful growth for our club and provides a safe, nurturing and quality program choice for all levels of play.

I continued with the Executive's mandate to encourage and support all our coaches in improving and advancing their training. Every division has a minimum training expectation for our coaches and all coaches are free to continue to participate in all the various sessions offered both for their own personal information (sessions offered by our Technical Director) and for certification (sessions offered by Concordia Soccer Association). The more highly qualified coaches we have in our association, the better quality of players and calibre of soccer.

I have been so proud to have served on the Executive Committee, Conseil d'Administration, Competitive Committee and Tournament Committee during 2009. The passion for soccer and commitment of the volunteers I have worked with in NDGSA has been wonderful. While everyone involved with NDG Soccer has missed Jean Daniel Eigenmann this year, I have been impressed by how we have all worked together as a team to carry on, thrive and grow stronger. It has been an honour to his memory.

Let us move forward into the future and continue to encourage all players to find a home in our Association. NDG Soccer Association will keep working diligently to provide a safe environment for players to learn, and improve their skills while providing them with opportunities to play at all levels of competitive and recreational soccer.

VP RECREATIONAL DIVISION REPORT - 2009

The recreational division of the NDG Soccer Association once again organized summer soccer for 1,400 players and coaches. Although one of the largest soccer clubs in Concordia, this represented a slight decline from past years and remains a concern to the NDGSA. Most noticeable is the continual problem of attracting teenage girls in our various divisions. The highlights of our summer and winter programs are summarized as follows.

Novice Division

Our numbers in our U-4, 5 & 6 divisions continue to be strong and amounted to 305 children in 2009 versus 307 in 2008. We decided this year to provide both a boy's and girl's division and this proved very beneficial to both groups and was welcomed by the parents. As well, with the City, we purchased new nets for this division which made the games more realistic for the kids. Pizza Pizza sponsored the U 5F division thanks to the efforts of Eric Bonfanti and Cate.

Mini-field Division

The mini-field division operated well in 2009 with few problems. Coaches were found for all teams and the games were equally competitive. Highlights include:-

- The total number of girls and boys in this division amounted to 157 and 317 respectively, a decline of 7 boys and 11 girls from 2008.
- The division provided players for 2 new IC teams in 2009.
- The mini-field division included U-7, U-8, U-9, and U-10 boy's divisions and U-7/8 and U-9/10 girl's divisions.
- We agreed to accept 3 teams from ASSOM, 2 in the U9 boys and 1 in the U10 boys division. The close proximity of ASSOM was acceptable to the coaches and parents in this division.
- Allstar teams were formed in the U- 5M, U7M, U7F, U8F, U10F, U9M and U10M divisions and most teams played 2 tournaments. The U-7 boys under the coaching of Tony Pulcini and Fiona Wright played in 4 tournaments (funding 2 seperately), winning them all.
- The CSA Mini Soccer festival as presented by BMO was again held in August with Novice (U4/5/6) and Minifield Girls playing on Saturday and the Minifield Boys on Sunday. The festival was sponsored by BMO, Adidas, Sony, Telus, Egg Farmers of Canada, Kellogg's, Kumon, Sportchek, State Farm, Yahoo and the Government of Canada and included presentations by Egg Farmers of Canada and Kumon. The festival was a great success - a credit to Cate, Maddie, Susan and the coaches.

Full-Field Divisions

This year, we continued to have U-12, U-14, U-17, and U-21 divisions for both girls and boys. Our numbers were similar to past years. With the exception of the U-21 division, the boys had 4 teams and the girls 3 teams in each of the division. We accepted a team from the Homenetmen in the girl's U-17 division. Highlights include:-

- The total number of girls and boys in this division amounted to 188 and 276 respectively, a decline of 9 girls from 2008 and an increase of 9 boys from 2008.
- The division provided players for existing and developing IC teams because of NDGSA successes in achieving AAA status for 4 teams.
- Allstar teams were formed in the U12M, U14M, U14F, and U16M divisions and again these teams played in 1-2 tournaments.
- This was the first year for the U-21 division which included sufficient players for 2 boy's teams and 1 girl's team. The boys played against Ken Henriksen's recreational senior team forming a 3 team league which was very successful. Thanks go to Ken, Mark Blaker, Brian Shore and Youcef Boukert for their dedicated work.

- With one U-21 girl's team, games were organized against Bob Povacz's senior recreational and competitive women as well as the U-17 girl's teams. Generally all concerned enjoyed themselves. Thanks go to Doug Allen and Bob Povacz for their assistance.
- The finals for all full field divisions were held on the weekend of September 12/13, 2009 and judging by the parents and friends in the stands, were very successful.

Senior Divisions

We continue to promote soccer among seniors to give them an opportunity to play a recreational game of soccer. Currently, we have an active senior men's group that plays every week and is under the co-ordination of Ken Henricksen. This group continues to expand. We initiated a recreational women's program with the assistance of Doug Allen and Bob Povacz to emulate what Ken has been able to accomplish with the men. While we did not achieve the numbers that we had hoped to do this year, we established a solid base to grow in 2010.

Referees

Clinics for the referees were presented by Concordia in the spring in preparation for the 2009 season and all new referees attended. We also provided our refresher course under the instruction of Evans Velloza to all returning referees. The co-ordination of the recreational referees was under the control of Simon Rodrigue-Witchel with technical assistance from Evans. We experienced very few problems in 2009 and our thanks go to both Simon and Evans.

Coaches

The success of our programs is dependent on our coaches, assistant coaches, and other volunteers. With a few minor exceptions, we were able to field both coaches and assistant coaches for all teams. Our goal remains to develop younger coaches and we successfully attracted 6 coaches under the age of 25. We continue to encourage our coaches to obtain training and 41 recreational coaches attended the Concordia clinics. We heartily thank all of our coaches and assistants for their dedication to our recreational program.

Technical

Gustavo was available to assist the recreational coaches. The emphasis was on both developing our younger players as well as assisting the Allstar coaches. We will endeavor to continue to utilize Gustavo's skills in 2010.

Winter Soccer

We continue to expand our winter program with children ranging in ages from U-4 to U-17. Our goal remains to continue to expand this program in 2010.

Administrative

The recreational program continues to be ably administered by Cate and Maddie whose time and efforts are greatly appreciated by the coaches and parents. This summer, the office was open 5 days per week which made life much easier for everyone.

Treasurer's Report / Rapport de Trésorier

We were not able to find anyone with the suitable qualifications who was willing to give the extensive volunteer hours needed to maintain this position. This position, as are all the positions on the Executive of NDGSA is a total volunteer position. I had to continue to perform the extra responsibilities and duties of the Treasurer. We are grateful to and thank Catia Vani for her extreme dedication, cooperation and responsibility. With her assistance, we were able to perform the functions of the Treasurer. These duties include all financial aspects of the club, volunteer rebates, payments to suppliers for uniforms, medals, office supplies, advertising, minifestival expenses, payroll, invoices from F.S.Q., Concordia, government remittances, the bank reconciliation statements, and the closing and opening of each fiscal year. A special thank you to our GM Competitive, Rino Lisella and our GM Recreational, Cate Gregory who both spent many hours verifying and approving expense reports and refund requests. They would prepare these requests and members of the Executive would review and approve them for payment. The approved requests would then be sent to our Accounting Administrator who would issue the cheques. We have also spent many hours preparing all documentation to be delivered to our C.A. firm, Groupe Hébert Crispo and the C.A. in charge of our account, M. René Chaput. Please refer to the completed financial statements included in this report. They will be available to every member of the Association and posted on our website, www.ndgsa.com very soon..

NDG Soccer Association is a very large association comprising about 1,850 players. Our annual operating budget is approximately \$650,000.00. I dedicated myself to being the fiscal guardian of the association, being accountable to every member of NDGSA. While the *Conseil d'Administration* has always received monthly financial reports, since 2008 our Past President, the late Jean Daniel Eigenmann and myself, the Executive Vice-President, implemented the new accounting system – we devoted countless hours to this enormous task in order to give the NDG Soccer Association a fully organized and updated method for maintaining all accounting procedures and budgets. I have worked tirelessly to continue the implementation and improvement of our new accounting system. Every division now has their own budget and they must use this information in planning all expenses.

The final Volunteer Rebate cheques were issued, as promised, for summer 2009. We feel extremely saddened to have abolished the Volunteer Rebates. This topic was discussed and debated at great length during our *Conseil d'Administration* meetings held in 2008. Even though several years ago we had a \$120,000.00 surplus, since 2006 we have given this reserve back to the volunteers through the Volunteer Rebate Program. The initiative behind the Volunteer Rebate Program was to stimulate additional motivated volunteer parents to join the Association and to take over some of the more responsible positions within the different divisions of the club and at the *Conseil d'Administration* level. Unfortunately, this has not happened and with great sadness the CA felt it necessary to protect our \$20,000 reserve and abolish these volunteer rebates for 2010.

The entire NDGSA Executive will continue to work hard to provide the best and highest quality soccer experience to all our players while maintaining the financial health of our Association.

Director of Registration's Report

Our Director of Registration, Carla O'Hanley, relocated from the NDG area and had to step down from her position in November 2009. The Executive of NDG Soccer Association wishes to extend their thanks to her for her invaluable contributions and efforts in organizing our very successful registrations in January, February and March of last year.

The registrations were held on January 24, February 15, and March 14, 2009 and were made possible by the generosity and dedication of our volunteers. There were new volunteers as well as our regular group of experienced parents and coaches. The tradition of pizza, doughnuts, muffins and soft drinks/water/coffee for the volunteers was continued.

Thank you to all volunteers as your help was invaluable.

The mailing of the registration forms is always our Association's most effective method of communicating. We have a 75%+ return rate on these registration forms (with players completing them at home and bringing them to registration). We made a change in our mailing preparation, however, as we held the "envelope stuffing" during the day and at night. We had quite a few people who were able to come in during the day and this meant that the entire envelope stuffing was completed and mailed in one day. The other methods of distributing forms we also used were (our www.ndgsa.com website, by City postal codes, and at Play-It-Again Sports and Sports-Au-Gus). We thank these stores for their help!

All three registration dates accepted recreational as well as competitive registrations but a late fee applied for competitive registrations after the February 15, 2009 registration and after the March 14, 2009 for the recreational registrations. The late fee remained \$50.

The Competitive division continued to register their players for whole year only. This system allows for a smooth transition from season to season. It also affords the teams the opportunity to continue to practice and develop as a team throughout the winter.

Summer 2009 Registrations totalled 1,745 players (1,243 recreational and 502 competitive)

Summer 2008 Registrations totalled 1,839 players.

Winter recreational registrations totalled 216 players for 2009/10 and 260 players for 2008/09.
